JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, Ag.C.J.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader. No notice is being issued to the respondent Nos. 5 to 8 in view of the order which is being passed.

2. Petitioner, alleging to be the Secretary of Azhoor Bhagavathi Temple Trust, has come up with this writ petition seeking police protection with regard to the conduct of festival to be held from 15.03.2015 to 24.03.2015. According to the petitioner, private respondents are earlier office bearers. Petitioner's case is that they have been expelled and now, the petitioner is the Secretary of the Trust. In this Writ Petition we need not enter into the issue as to who are the valid office bearers.

3. Learned Government Pleader submits that in so far as the temple festival is concerned, sufficient police personnel shall be deputed to ensure that there is no law and order problem.

4. In the above view of the matter, we do not think that any further direction is needed in the matter. We only observe that police authorities shall ensure that law and order situation is maintained as far as the temple festival is concerned.

With the above observation, the Writ Petition is closed.
