JUDGMENT

The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

"i. Issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction directing the 1st respondent to consider and dispose of Ext.P3 petition filed by the petitioner, within a time frame to be fixed by this Hon'ble Court.

ii. To issue such other order or direction as this Honourable Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been projected by way of Ext.P3 petition which is pending consideration before the 1st respondent and the prayer is only to cause the same to be considered and disposed within a reasonable time.

2. Heard the learned Government Pleader as well.

3. Considering the limited nature of the relief sought for, this Court does not find it necessary to go into the merits of the case. The writ petition is disposed of, directing the 1st respondent

to consider and pass appropriate orders on Ext.P3 in accordance with law, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and other interested parties, if any, at the earliest, at any rate, within 'two months' from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment. The petitioner shall produce a copy of the judgment along with a copy of the writ petition before the 1st respondent for further steps.

The writ petition is disposed of.
