JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J

This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection, alleging that obstruction is being caused by private respondents in the matter relating to functioning of various wholesale distribution depots.

2. An interim order has been passed by this court on 3.5.2013.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the interim order was passed, no untoward incident has been reported.

4. Under such circumstances, we do not think that any direction as sought for, is required to be passed in this case. We only observe that if there is any further obstruction from the private respondents, it shall be open for the petitioner to approach the police, who shall look into the matter.

With the above direction, the writ petition is closed.
