JUDGMENT

The petitioner threatened with revenue recovery proceedings to recover the court fee, has approached this Court.

2. The petitioner's suit as well as the restoration application have been dismissed for non prosecution. The petitioner thereafter filed I.A. for restoration along with an application to condone delay. Those I.A's were posted for consideration on 01.08.2015 by the learned Sub Judge.

3. This Court called for a report and the learned Sub Judge requested for 20 days time to dispose I.A. No.5594/2013 in O.S. No.168/2006. In that view of the matter, the revenue recovery proceedings are liable to be deferred for a period of six weeks, to enable the petitioner, to work out the alternate remedy.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
