JUDGMENT

The petitioner confines his relief to easy instalments to pay the amount due under the awards in ARC Nos. 684/2014 and 685/2014. I permit the petitioner to pay the amounts due in six equal monthly instalments starting from 16.04.2015.

2. The coercive steps pursuant to Exts.P3 and P4 demand notices shall be put on hold if the petitioner complies with the conditions in time. The coercive steps shall surge ahead if the petitioner commits default in the payment of any one of the instalments as directed.

3. The respondents are free to apply for review of this judgment if aggrieved by the instalment facility granted.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
