This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection alleging that second respondent association is not taking such steps by which the petitioner is prevented from carrying on farm fishing in his property. Interim order has already been passed by this Court on 30.4.2013.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of the interim order passed, there is no law and order situation, however, it may arise every year.
