JUDGMENT

The grievance of the petitioners in the writ petition is that, the respondents, acting under the Kerala Revenue Recovery Act, 1968, [for short, the 'Act'] for recovery of the amounts due from their son, have sought to proceed against their properties in terms of the Act.

2. I have heard Sri.Philip T.Varghese, the learned counsel for the petitioners and Sri.Shyson P.Manguzha, the learned Government Pleader for the respondents.

The learned Government Pleader on instructions would submit that, the respondents are proceeding only against the properties of the son of the petitioners and not against the properties of the petitioners.
