J U D G M E N T

The petitioner limits its relief to easy installments to pay the amount covered by Exts. P1 and P2 notices. I permit the petitioner to pay the dues with applicable interest in three equal monthly installments starting from 30.04.2015.

2. The coercive steps pursuant to Ext.P3 notice shall be put on hold if the petitioner complies with the conditions in time. The coercive steps can surge ahead if the petitioner commits default in the payment of any one of the installments as directed.

3. This judgment does not disable the respondents from adjusting any amount if any due to the petitioner by way of refund towards the demand raised in Ext. P1 and P2 notices.

The writ petition is disposed of.
