JUDGMENT

The petitioner has approached this Court with the following prayers:

*"i. To issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, commanding the 2nd respondent to consider and pass orders on **Ext.P3** within a time frame fixed by this Hon'ble court.*

ii. To issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, commanding the 2nd respondent to permit petitioner for utilising the land comprised in Block No.04 of Re survey No.155/2, 155/3 and 155/6 of Thrikandiyur Village of Malappuram District for the purposes other than paddy cultivation as per Kerala Land Utilisation Order.

iii. And to pass such other appropriate orders or directions as this Hon'ble Court deems fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case."

2. Heard the learned Government Pleader as well.

3. Considering the limited extent of relief sought for, this Court does not find it necessary to go into the merit of the case.

The writ petition is disposed of, directing the second

respondent/ Revenue Divisional Officer to consider and pass appropriate orders on Ext.P3 as per the Kerala Land Utilisation Order. It shall be done, after hearing the petitioner, at the earliest, at any rate, within 'two months' from the date of receipt of a copy of the judgment.

The petitioner shall produce a copy of the judgment, along with a copy of the writ petition, before the second respondent, for further steps.
