Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Government Pleader as well.

2. This Writ Petition has been filed alleging police harassment. The 5th respondent is the daughter-in-law of the petitioners. Allegations have been made that the petitioners have been assaulted.

3. The learned Government Pleader, after obtaining instructions, submitted that a complaint was filed by the 5th respondent that she was being evicted out of the house. Hence, the police had come and enquired the matter.

4. Taking note of the fact that a complaint was submitted by the 5th respondent, having been stated by the

learned Government Pleader, we do not feel this case as a case of any police harassment. Police was duty bound to respond to the complaint submitted by the 5th respondent.
