JUDGMENT

The petitioner in the above writ petition is a regular stage carriage permit holder operating vehicle bearing Reg. No. KL-3 P/4822 in the route Thrissur-Thriprayar. The timings of the service was last allotted on 03.07.1981, hence the petitioner filed an application to revise the timings by Ext.P2 dated 20.3.2014. The petitioner prays for an expeditious consideration of his application.
