JUDGMENT

The petitioner alleges illegality in the recruitment process for the post of peon. The petitioner contends that the appointees have been decided even before the rank list. The petitioner has in this regard submitted Ext.P3 representation to the first respondent.

2. I direct the first respondent to consider Ext.P3 representation with notice to the petitioner and the third respondent bank. Respondents 4 to 6 impleaded in this writ petition shall also be put on notice. Final orders on Ext.P3 representation shall be passed within a period of two months.

3. The recruitment process can go on as scheduled. The same will be subject to the orders being passed on Ext.P3 representation.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
