JUDGMENT

All that the petitioner prays is for easy instalments to pay the amount due. The petitioner shall pay a sum of ₹50,000/- to the third respondent bank on or before 20.04.2015. The petitioner shall pay a further sum of ₹1 lakh on or before 30.05.2015. The balance amount shall be paid in six equal monthly instalments starting from 30.06.2015.

2. The coercive steps pursuant to Ext.P2 notice shall be put on hold if the petitioner complies with the conditions above. The coercive steps can surge ahead if the petitioner commits default in the payment of any one of the instalments as directed.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
