JUDGMENT

The petitioner is a rival operator of the second respondent. The petitioner's grievance is in so far as the second respondent being allowed to operate on a temporary permit on the basis of the proposed timings without any finalisation being made. It is submitted that re-issuance is also effected as per Ext.P3, without any settlement of timing as such. The petitioner is also said to have filed Ext.P2 objection. In such circumstances, if the second respondent's timings have not been finalised in a validly convened timing conference, the same shall be done at any rate within two months from today after issuing notice to the second respondent and after displaying public notice.

Writ petition is disposed of.
