The writ petition has been filed on the premise that no appellate authority has been constituted wherein Exts.P1 and P2 bills could be challenged. The respondents point out that an appellate authority has been constituted pursuant to the decision in **Muhammed Haji Vs. Kerala State Electricity Board [2014(3) KLT 706]**.

2. It is open to the petitioner to challenge Exts.P1 and P2 bills before the appellate authority if the same are maintainable as per law. Any such appeal filed within one month from today shall be dealt with within three months therefrom.
