JUDGMENT

This Court while admitting the writ petitions granted a stay of recovery of arrears of electricity dues. The petitioners were however directed to pay energy charges at the rates applicable to LT VII A category. The same arrangement shall continue till the disposal of the S.L.P. Nos. 1822-1826/2010 by the Supreme Court. This course has been adopted by this Court in similar writ petitions. The realisation of the arrears (which remain stayed) shall be subject to the outcome of the case by the Supreme Court.

The writ petitions are disposed of.
