JUDGMENT

Petitioners have approached this Court challenging the proceedings initiated by the Taluk Land Board against them. The petitioner in W.P.(C) No.14402/2015 challenges the proceedings of the Taluk Land Board in SMC No.1/2009. The petitioner in W.P.(C) No.13760/2015 challenges the same proceedings.

This Court is of the view that the petitioners shall raise an objection before the Land Board. This shall be done within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment. Thereafter, after adverting to the objection, the Taluk Land Board is free to pass any orders in this matter in accordance with law. The petitioners are free to appear before the Taluk Land Board through duly authorised counsel except when the petitioners are required to be examined as witnesses.

The writ petitions are disposed of as above.
