JUDGMENT

The petitioner contends that a stay wire through his property should be avoided if possible. The electricity line (along the proposed route) does not cross his property.

2. The petitioner has suggested an alternate route. Ext.P4 sketch produced along with the reply affidavit indicates this route.

3. I direct the second respondent to consider the alternate proposal suggested by the petitioner. The same shall be done within a period of one month from today.

4. The petitioner shall produce a copy of the writ petition and the connected pleadings before the second respondent for compliance.
