The petitioners raised Exts.P3 and P4 objections for granting temporary permit one after other continuously to the 4th respondent for his vehicle bearing registration No.KL-17/A 9680 claiming to be in the vacancy of KL 7/AL 3153.

In that view of the matter, the first respondent shall consider Exts.P3 and P4 objections before settling the timings, after notice to the petitioners and 4th respondent or any others, who are operating on the route Kunjithai - Paravoor - Ernakulam mentioned in Exts.P3 and P4. Therefore, settlement of timings shall be done by the first respondent finally, after adverting to the objections, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
