JUDGMENT

The petitioner had become the owner of the landed property by virtue of Ext.P1 registered will. Immediately after the registration of Ext.P1 will, application was submitted to the 5th respondent to effect mutation in favour of the petitioner. But the 5th respondent had declined to effect mutation. Then the petitioner had approached the 4th respondent with Ext.P5 application alongwith relevant documents. Being aggrieved by the delay in effecting mutation, the petitioner has approached this Court.

2. Considering the facts and circumstances, there will be a direction to the 4th respondent to consider Ext.P5 application, after notice to the petitioner, 6th respondent and all other affected persons within a period of two months.

The Writ Petition is disposed of as above.
