JUDGMENT

Petitioner is a widower and a chronic liver disease patient. Petitioner filed Ext.P6 application for issuance of Legal Heirship Certificate before the second respondent. Petitioner again filed Ext.P7 application before the second respondent as he came to know that Ext.P6 application filed by him was misplaced from the file. But so far, no action has been taken to issue Legal Heirship Certificate. Aggrieved, petitioner approached this Court.

In view of the above, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to consider Exts.P6 and P7 applications for issuance of Legal Heirship Certificate in accordance with law, after conducting necessary enquiry, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
