JUDGMENT

The above writ petition was filed challenging the seniority list of Junior Health Inspector Gr.II issued by the second respondent. The contention raised is that the seniority list has been issued in violation of the principle of a statewide combined seniority list and in violation of Rule 27(c) of the KS & SSR. However, this writ petition is one filed in the year 2004 and the petitioners have not taken any effort to put forth the subsequent events which would have occurred on the Government acting as per the seniority list impugned herein.

In such circumstances, nothing survives in the writ petition and there is also no appearance for the petitioners. Hence the Writ Petition would stand dismissed.
