Thottathil B. Radhakrishnan, J.

Petitioner is the Temple Advisory Committee of Sree MahaVishnu - Sree Subramanya Temple, Nedumprayar. Going by the materials and pleadings, it appears that the said temple has been recently renovated. The representation of the TAC says that the Thanthri has advised that there should be regular poojas, not confined to one a day. Having regard to all attendant circumstances, the Travancore Devaswom Board is directed to take representation of the petitioner into consideration and issue necessary decision in accordance with the advice of the Thanthri without fail within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.

The Writ Petition is ordered accordingly.
