J U D G M E N T

The petitioner was before this Court claiming advise by the Public Service Commission (PSC) since she figured in Ext.P1 list published by the PSC for the post of Typist in the Kerala State Financial Enterprises Ltd.

2. As per the interim order of this Court, the PSC is said to have advised the petitioner and the petitioner was appointed and is continuing in service. In fact, the writ petition itself was filed seeking a direction to the 2nd respondent to report all the available vacancies and for consequent advise and appointment from Ext.P1 rank list. There could be no other cloud on the eligibility of the petitioner to be so appointed.

3. If the petitioner's appointment is otherwise proper the same shall regularised and she be continued in service with all consequential benefits.
