JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection alleging threat from the 5th respondent. Apparently the complaint of the petitioner was that an attempt has been made to forcibly evict the petitioner and his family members from the residence. It is also stated that a Civil Suit is pending between the parties.

2. By an interim order dated 20.06.2014 this Court had directed the District Police Chief, Kollam to look into the complaint, if any, lodged by the petitioner or his daughter and do the needful.

3. Learned Government Pleader on instructions would submit that after the aforesaid interim order, no untoward incident has been reported.

In the said circumstances we close this Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Police if there is any further cause of action.
