Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader.

2. Petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking police protection. Petitioner has prayed for a direction to the 3rd respondent to provide necessary protection for the petitioner and his men for completing the reclamation as permitted by Ext.P1 order. In pursuance of Ext.P1 order, petitioner claims to have started work, which was obstructed by certain private persons. On 6/1/2015, the Village Officer has issued a stop memo, which was withdrawn on 28th of April, 2015. Learned Government Pleader submits that the petitioner has thereafter not even informed the police of any obstruction by anyone.

In view of the above, we see no reason to entertain the writ petition at this stage, However, we observe that in the event any

obstruction is caused, it is open for the petitioner to approach the police authorities by appropriate complaint. With this observation, the writ petition is closed.
