JUDGMENT

This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection in the matter relating to plying of autorickshaw by the petitioner. It is stated that 4th respondent has obstructed the petitioner from plying her vehicle in terms of the permit.

2. An interim order was issued by this Court on 7.8.2013 directing the police to ensure maintenance of law and order.

3. Learned Government Pleader, on instructions, would submit that after the interim order was passed, no untoward incident has been reported. Hence, we close the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the police if there is any further cause of action.
