Seeking for a direction to the respondent to consider Ext.P2 application for re-issue of temporary permit, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

The petitioner, who is the owner of a stage carriage, submitted an application for re-issue of temporary permit on the route between Kureepuzha and Tanni Temple via Panamukku in the vacancy of defaulted service stage carriage bearing Reg.No.KL 11/N 3600.
