JUDGMENT

The petitioner had availed a loan from the District Industrial Centre, Ernakulam. This was for the purpose of Small Scale Unit conducted by the petitioner. It appears that the Small Scale Unit has been closed down. The petitioner approached the second respondent by Ext.P3 for One Time Settlement Scheme. The petitioner highlighted his grievances in Ext.P3 for his inability to run the Unit and repay the loan amount.

In that view of the matter, an appropriate decision shall be taken by the third respondent if any Scheme is otherwise available for settling the liability by availing One Time Settlement Scheme. Needful shall be done within a period of two months after hearing the petitioner. Till a decision is taken as above, all coercive steps against the petitioner shall be deferred.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
