JUDGMENT

Aggrieved by the inaction on the part of the respondents in revaluating the answer papers of the petitioner, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. According to the petitioner, she applied for scrutiny and revaluation of “Financial Management Principles” paper for her M.Com course. Scrutiny has already been done and she had understood that five of her answers were not properly valued. She has obtained employment for which she has to produce M.Com Certificate before 31.6.2015. According to the petitioner, if the revaluation is not done immediately, the petitioner would lose her employment. It is with this background, the petitioner has come up before this Court.
