This writ petition has been filed seeking police protection for the life of the petitioners. It is alleged that obstruction was being caused by respondents 3 to 5. A perusal of the averments in the writ petition clearly discloses an issue relating to custody of a minor child.

2. A statement has been filed on behalf of the second respondent narrating the sequences in which custody of the minor child has been given to the grandmother, who is the first petitioner. After filing of the writ petition, no untoward incident has been reported.
