Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned State Attorney. No notice is being issued to respondents 4 and 5 in view of the judgment being passed.

2. In this writ petition, petitioner has prayed for a direction to respondents 1 and 2 to provide necessary police protection for peaceful conduct of election to Pallikkal Bazaar Juma-ath Palli Mahal Committee, which is scheduled to take place on 14th of June, 2015. Petitioner's case is that election has been directed on the orders of the Kerala State Wakf Board. Petitioner apprehends disturbance at the instance of private respondents.

3. Learned State Attorney submits that sufficient police protection shall be provided to ensure that no law and order situation arises and election is conducted peacefully.

In the above view of the matter, we close the writ petition with the observation that police authorities shall ensure maintenance of law and order at the site of election scheduled to take place on 14th of June, 2015.
