J U D G M E N T

The petitioner is aggrieved by the non consideration of Ext.P2 application submitted by the petitioner for variation of conditions of permit. He alleges that though Ext.P2 application was circulated among the members of the 1st respondent by the 2nd respondent, final orders are not yet passed in the matter.
