Exts.P3 and P4 final bills issued in terms of Section 126 of the Electricity Act, 2003 are impugned. The petitioner has an effective alternative remedy by way of an appeal. An appeal lies under Section 127 of the Electricity Act, 2003 wherein, all legal and factual issues can be urged. I do not think that a case for interference invoking the writ jurisdiction of this Court is made out.

2. The status quo as on today shall be maintained for a period of one month to enable the petitioner to work out his remedy as indicated above.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
