J U D G M E N T

Seeking temporary permit under Section 87(1)(d) of the Motor Vehicles Act to continue the service as limited stop ordinary service, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

2. The petitioner is a regular permit holder on the route between Thulappilly and Ernakulam in respect of stage carriage bearing Reg.No.KL-17/K 5796, which is valid till 21.06.2015. As his application for renewal is pending consideration, the petitioner has applied for temporary permit under Section 87(1)(d) of the Motor Vehicles Act. The petitioner's grievance is that the respondent, who is statutorily bound to issue temporary permit, has not considered the same till date. Hence, this writ petition.
