JUDGMENT

Ashok Bhushan, Ag.C.J.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader.

2. The petitioner has filed this writ petition alleging police harassment. A direction has been sought restraining respondents 1 to 5 from harassing the petitioner on the basis of the vexatious complaints filed by respondents 6 to 9. Petitioner's case is that private respondents 6 to 9 have filed several complaints who claimed to be the office bearers of Citizen's Vigilance Committee. It is submitted that on the said complaint, petitioner has been called by respondents 1 to 5. It is further submitted that the petitions filed against respondents by the petitioner have been ignored by respondents 1 to 5.

3. Learned Government Pleader after obtaining instructions submitted that both the petitioner and private respondents have filed several complaints against each other which were enquired into by the police authorities and

most of them have been referred. It is submitted that no action of harassment has been meted out at the hands of police authorities.

In view of the fact that complaints have been filed by private individuals which were enquired into and petitioner's complaints have already been enquired, we see no case of police harassment in this case. With the above observation, the Writ Petition is closed.
