JUDGMENT

The petitioner seeking a early disposal of proceedings initiated as per Ext.P5. The petitioner's case is that the petitioner's husband Mr.John was expired on 20.12.2002 and was buried in parish cemetery. Thereafter, it is noticed without consent of the petitioner's family members, the petitioner's husband body was exhumed and removed and whereabouts is not known. The petitioner raised a complaint. The Tahsildar issued a notice as per Ext.P5.

2. This Court is of the view that appropriate decision shall be taken by Tahsildar based on Ext.P5 after hearing the petitioner and respondents 3 to 8. Needful shall be done within a period of three months. It is open for the Tahsildar to refer this entire matter before the Revenue Divisional Officer for consideration.

The writ petition is disposed of as above.
