Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Government Pleader.

2. This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking police protection from private respondents 1 to 5. It is stated that private respondents are their neighbours and there is dispute pertaining to a pathway between the parties. Petitioners' case is that they were attacked by the private respondents on 7.3.2015 and on 27.3.2015, the son of the first petitioner was again attacked by them, with regard to which, a complaint, Ext.P1, has been filed on 31.3.2015.

3. Learned Government Pleader on instructions would submit that the complaint was enquired and a referral report has been submitted. It is submitted that with regard to the incident dated 7.3.2015, a crime has already been registered against the 2nd petitioner and it has been charge sheeted. It is further submitted that Ext.P1 complaint was enquired and it was found

that there is no further incident apart from the incident on 7.3.2015 and that is why, the referral report has been filed. In so far as the referral report is concerned, the petitioners shall take such steps as permissible under law.

In the above view of the matter, we do not find any reason to issue any direction as prayed for in the writ petition at this stage. It is hence, closed.
