All the operators on the route shall be put on notice before allotting a time slot to them. Needless to say that Ext. P4 representation put in by the second respondent and Ext. 2. All the operators including the petitioner and the second respondent shall adhere to the time slot now allotted to them till a decision is taken afresh in the timing conference. The timing conference shall be held within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this judgment.
