JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

This writ petition is filed seeking police protection inter alia alleging that respondents 6 and 7 and their men are creating obstruction in the functioning of the office premises of the 1st petitioner company.

2. Learned Government Pleader on instructions would submit that on account of the conciliation meeting in the presence of police officials, the entire issues were settled between the parties and at present there is no agitation in the petitioner's office. Learned counsel for the petitioners have also admitted the said fact.

Under such circumstances, we do not think it necessary to issue any direction in the matter. The Writ Petition is closed with liberty to the petitioner to approach this Court again in case of any further cause of action.
