J U D G M E N T

The petitioner was granted 6 instalments to pay the amount demanded in Ext.P1 notice by Ext.P2 order. The petitioner contends that he has paid 4 instalments as borne out by Ext.P3 series receipts.

2. The petitioner contends that the amounts already remitted works out to 130% of the original demand referred to in Ext.P1 notice. The petitioner seeks waiver of the balance two instalments as directed in Ext.P2 order.

3. Ext.P4 representation put in by the petitioner is pending consideration. I direct the second respondent to consider Ext.P4 representation with notice to the petitioner within one month. The time fixed for payment of the fifth instalment as directed in Ext.P2 order is extended by one month.
