J U D G M E N T

The limited prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on Ext.P3, which was submitted by the petitioner for reissue of temporary permit.

2. The petitioner, who is the owner of stage carriage No.KL 23 C/7131, is operating service on the route between Kayamkulam and Kollam on the basis of temporary permit, which is issued in the vacant timing of stage carriage bearing Reg.No.KL 02 T/1684, which is valid till 23.08.2015. According to the petitioner, since there is temporary need on account of non-operation of regular service, there is warranting circumstance to grant and issue temporary permit. Hence, the petitioner submitted Ext.P3 application for reissue of temporary permit. Alleging inaction on the part of the respondent in

considering Ext.P2, the petitioner has come up before this Court.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Government Pleader in the matter.
