J U D G M E N T

The limited prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondent to consider and pass appropriate orders on Ext.P1, which was submitted by the petitioner for temporary permit.

2. The petitioner is the registered owner of a stage carriage bearing Reg.No.KL 17 C/8343. He applied for temporary permit on the route between Panampukadu and Medical College Bus Stand. He alleges that there is no stage carriage service operating on the said route and the circumstance warrants issue of temporary permit. Alleging inaction on the part of the respondent in considering Ext.P1, the petitioner has come up before this Court.
