JUDGMENT

This is a case of short assessment of the electricity charges consumed by the petitioner. Ext.P3 demand notice served on the petitioner in this regard is impugned.

2. The petitioner has an effective alternate remedy under Regulation 130(8) of the Kerala Electricity Supply Code, 2014. The Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum can therefore be moved by the petitioner for ventilation of his grievance.

3. Any motion made in this regard within one month from today shall be dealt within two months therefrom. The coercive steps pursuant to Ext.P3 notice shall be put on hold for a period of three months.

The Writ Petition is disposed of.
