JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking police protection alleging that he is under severe threat from respondents 4 to 8. An interim order has already been passed by this Court on 21.10.2013.

2. Learned Government Pleader submits that after the interim order has been passed, no untoward incident has been reported and that respondents are the wife, son-in-law and daughter of the petitioner.

3. Having regard to the aforesaid facts, we do not think it necessary to pass any further orders in the matter. If there is any further complaint, it shall be open for the petitioner to approach the Police, who shall enquire the matter and do the needful.

The Writ Petition is disposed of as above.
