JUDGMENT

The grievance of the petitioner is that the electricity supply has been snapped even during the pendency of a statutory appeal. It is reported that one half of the amount demanded has already been paid while filing Ext.P4 appeal.

2. I direct the third respondent to dispose of Ext.P4 appeal with notice to the petitioner within a period of three months. The electricity connection to consumer Nos. 9492 and 21530 shall be restored in the meanwhile within a period of one week.
