JUDGMENT

Petitioner was before this Court challenging the transfer, which allegedly was against the transfer policy of the Airports Authority of India, as is indicated in Ext.P1. Learned counsel for the Airports Authority of India submits that the transfer was in accordance with the policy, but however would place on record Ext.R3(b), by which Ext.P2 transfer order itself was cancelled, which is one day after the writ petition was filed. In such circumstances, nothing survives in the writ petition. Writ petition is dismissed as infructuous, leaving open the contentions of either parties.
