J U D G M E N T

The petitioner has approached this Court challenging revenue recovery proceedings based on the assessment order. Petitioner submits that he is contemplating to file an appeal against the assessment order and therefore revenue recovery proceedings may be deferred.

2. Taking note of the facts and circumstances, following directions are issued:

- (i) Petitioner shall remit ₹75,000/- on or before 12.08.2015 and another sum of ₹75,000/- within a further period of three weeks thereafter.
