J U D G M E N T

The petitioner approached the 2nd respondent for fixation of the boundary and effecting mutation consequent upon land acquisition.

2. It is seen from Ext.P1, the Taluk Surveyor has initiated steps for determination of demarcating the boundaries. The learned senior counsel appearing for the 5th respondent submits that they have also filed an application to demarcate his property.

3. Therefore this Court is of the view that appropriate steps shall be taken for the 4th respondent to complete the demarcation within three months from the date of receipt of the copy of this judgment after notice to the petitioners and 5th respondent. Based on the determination transfer of registry shall be effected in accordance with the law. The mutation shall be effected after taking note of the land acquisition as well as the final decree in partition suit No.O.S No.266/1997.

The writ petition is disposed of, as above.
