JUDGMENT

Shaffique, J.

The petitioner has approached this Court seeking police protection *inter alia* contending that he is being prevented by respondents 2 to 4 while he was vending fish by the side of National Highway.

2. Learned Government Pleader on instructions would submit that the petitioner had been directed to stop the fish vending in a busy area and that too by the side of National Highway causing nuisance to the public at large.

Having regard to the fact that street vending is not permissible by the side of National Highway, we do not think that any direction as sought for can be issued. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed.
